Policies and Procedures

Should I Attend Summer School?

Armada High School's Summer School program is designed to provide a credit recovery opportunity for those students who failed a class during the regular school year.



Students who fail required courses are encouraged to enroll in Summer School to stay on track for graduation.

No School July 4-7— Independence Break

Segments of classes are not re-offered during the regular school year, making

Summer School a great option to avoid repeating failed courses next year.

Keep In Mind:

All students must complete 1.5 credits each in Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra II.

Also, students must complete 6.0 credits of core English courses—English 9-12.

Courses Offered

Teacher-led courses **may** be available in Language Arts and Social Studies. Mathematics and Science courses are taught through Edgenuity with a teacher available to assist.

The teacher-led courses have limited homework compared to the online courses, and provide the support that online classes cannot offer.

Edgenuity Guidelines:

Online learning requires dedication and a realization that it takes lots of time.

Students should complete at least 20% of course content per 7 day week. Failure to move at this pace may result in a requirement to attend the Edgenuity class from 7:30-10:00.

All Edgenuity classes end on Wednesday, July 24. Incomplete Edgenuity classes will require a **\$20 service fee** for completion by August 31.

Edgenuity courses not completed by August 31 will be considered Incomplete and possibly deleted from the system.

Tuition:

\$150—Teacher Instructed Course

\$150—1st Online Course; \$100 per additional course...NOTE above deadlines and fees

Payment Plan available with a \$25 nonrefundable deposit by June 17. Completed courses will not be posted to a student academic record before full tuition and fees are paid.



Each class is worth 0.5 Credit. Some students take one class per session to earn 1.0 Credit during summer.

Attendance:

Teacher Led Courses:

Students attending Armada High School Summer School must make a commitment to learning. The courses meet only 20 days and will cover a large amount of material in a short time. Only 1 absence with proper verification is allowed. The second absence results in a 2 grade (20%) final grade reduction. The third absence results in loss of credit. 3 Tardies = 1 Absence.

Edgenuity Classes:

Once registered, students may begin working on their courses before classes begin June 19. Students are encouraged to attend the Edgenuity session in the media center from 7:30-10:00 and also encouraged to work on their classes from home and other off-campus locations.

Exams for Edgenuity courses must be taken in school.

Code of Conduct:

The Armada High School Code of Conduct applies to Summer School, including the Dress Code. Dress comfortably, but not inappropriately.

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
